20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
21

22 SECTION 1. Those persons vested by Article III of the Constitution of
23 the United States with the judicial power of the United States, Article III
24 Federal Judges, and those persons appointed and serving as United States
25 Bankruptcy Judges or United States Magistrate Judges in and for the Eastern
26 or Western Districts of Arkansas, may carry a concealed handgun.

28 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 5-73-119(c), concerning the possession of
29 concealed handguns by certain persons, is amended to add an additional
30 subdivision to read as follows:

31 (11) The person is vested by Article III of the Constitution of the
32 United States with the judicial power of the United States, Article III
33 Federal Judges, or the person is appointed and serving as a United States
34 Bankruptcy Judge or United States Magistrate Judge in and for the Eastern or
35 Western Districts of Arkansas.

1 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 5-73-120(c), concerning carrying a weapon,
2 is amended to add an additional subdivision to read as follows:

3 (9) The person is vested by Article III of the Constitution of the
4 United States with the judicial power of the United States, Article III
5 Federal Judges, or the person is appointed and serving as a United States
6 Bankruptcy Judge or United States Magistrate Judge in and for the Eastern or
7 Western Districts of Arkansas.
