3	(2) The disbursing officer shall give bond in the amount of two		
4	thousand dollars (\$2,000) or an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the		
5	total amount of estimated revenue of the school district for the school year		
6	covered by the bond, whichever is the greater, the maximum not to exceed		
7	twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000), for the faithful discharge of his dutie		
8	and for the proper accounting of all school money that may come into his		
9	hands or under his control, the surety on such bond to be a surety company		
10	authorized to do business in the State of Arkansas. The bond shall be filed		
11	in the office of the county clerk and a copy filed with the Director of the		
12	Department of Education. Premiums of such bonds shall be paid for by the		
13	board in the same manner as other fixed charges.		
14	(c) No warrant or check, other than food service or activity funds,		
15	shall be valid in absence of the following manual or facsimile signatures:		
16	(1) The designated board member serving as disbursing officer		
17	for the district, or the designated alternate; and		
18	(2) The superintendent of the school district.

20	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-17-918 is amended to read as follows:		
21	6-17-918. Issuing and countersigning warrants.		
22	(a) $\underline{(1)}$ It shall be the duty of the district superintendent of schools		
23	to serve as ex officio financial secretary and to issue and countersign all		
24	warrants.		
25	(2) All warrants and checks shall be issued in accordance with		
26	the provisions of $ 6-13-618(c) $ and $ 6-13-701(e) $.		
27	(b) The district superintendent of schools shall neither issue nor		
28	countersign any warrants or checks until he has determined that the warrants		
29	have been issued in conformity with \S 6-20-402, this subchapter, and other		
30	laws.		
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
