AN ACT TO CREATE THE SOUTH ARKANSAS SCHOOL OF
HOTEL AND HOSPITALITY MANAGEMENT; AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES.

Subtitle

AN ACT TO CREATE THE SOUTH ARKANSAS
SCHOOL OF HOTEL AND HOSPITALITY
MANAGEMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this act is to create the South Arkansas
School of Hotel and Hospitality Management to:

(1) Recognize the need for workforce training and education to
provide economic stimulus for Southeast Arkansas and the Delta region;

(2) Recognize that the hospitality industry is the fastest
growing employer in the world and that it provides substantial opportunity
for well trained applicants; and

(3) Recognize that the school would stimulate the economy of the
region not only by improving the employability of area citizens, but also, by
attracting students from around the country and the world.

SECTION 2. The South Arkansas School of Hotel and Hospitality
Management is created.
