18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-36-214, concerning the use of spot
21 lamps, fog lamps, and auxiliary passing and driving lamps, is amended to add
22 an additional subsection to read as follows:

23 (e) Ornamental Light Emitting Diodes White Lights. No motor vehicle
24 may be equipped with more than two (2) ornamental light emitting diodes white
25 lights mounted on the front of the vehicle.

27 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 27-36-221 is amended to read as follows:
28 27-36-221. Auxiliary driving lights.

29 It is unlawful to operate any motor vehicle on a public street or
30 highway with any auxiliary driving lights on unless such lights are original
31 equipment lighting installed by the vehicle manufacturer prior to the initial
32 retail sale of the motor vehicle, or fog lamps conforming to the provisions
33 set forth in § 27-36-214(b), or are auxiliary driving or passing lamps
34 conforming to the provisions set forth in § 27-36-214(c) and (d), or are
35 ornamental light emitting diodes white lights conforming to the provisions
36 set forth in § 27-36-214(e).
