21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-48-303 is amended to read as follows:
24 17-48-303. Right to enter - Immunity from arrest - Identification.

25 (a) Surveyors shall have the right to enter on public or private land
26 or waters, except buildings, in the lawful pursuit of their occupations and
27 shall be immune from arrest for trespass when performing their duties as
28 prescribed in this subchapter.

29 (b)(1) ~~Where practical, surveyors~~ Surveyors shall announce and
30 identify themselves and their intentions to the property owner and all
31 adjacent property owners before entering upon private property.

32 (2) Surveyors will carry means of proper identification as to
33 their registration or employment and will display the identification to
34 anyone requesting it.

35 (3) Surveyors shall not use the privilege granted herein to
36 extend that point of entry as determined by actual survey requirements.
