19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 21-1-402 is amended by adding an additional
22 subsection to read as follows:

23 (f) A former member of the Arkansas Senate or the Arkansas House of
24 Representatives shall not be eligible to be registered as a lobbyist under
25 Arkansas Code §§ 21-8-601 through 21-8-607 for one (1) year after the
26 expiration of the former member's term of office.
