25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

27 SECTION 1. The Senate and House Interim Committees on Public Health,  
28 Welfare, and Labor shall conduct a study to determine the feasibility and  
29 desirability of creating an Arkansas Pharmacy Reimbursement Allowance Program  
30 and present a comprehensive report of the findings to the President Pro  
31 Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives of the  
32 Eighty-Fifth General Assembly.
