6	(a) The specific design commemorating an African-American fraternity
7	or sorority for the special license plate shall be designed by each

11	(b) The director shall approve one (1) design for each participating

6	pay a design use contribution of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) at a subsequent
7	time of registration shall be issued a new plate that does not bear the
8	fraternity or sorority design, as otherwise provided by law.
9	(d) Upon expiration, the special African-American fraternity or
10	sorority license plate may be replaced with a conventional license plate, a

15	Special African-American fraternity or sorority license plates issued
16	under this subchapter may be transferred between vehicles under § 27-14-914.

18	27-15-3907. Compliance with other laws.
19	The special African-American fraternity or sorority license plates
20	shall comply with all other state motor vehicle laws relating to registration
21	and licensing of motor vehicles.

23	27-15-3908. Use of funds by the historically black institutions of
24	higher education.
25	(a) A participating Arkansas historically black institution of higher
26	education shall use one hundred percent (100%) of the funds received from the
27	design use authorization donation solely for academic or need-based
28	scholarships.
29	(b) Procedures and criteria used to determine the distribution of the
30	scholarships shall be established and followed by the endowment funds of the
31	participating Arkansas historically black institutions of higher education
32	distributing the funds derived from the fraternity and sorority license plate
33	program.

35	27-15-3909. Limitation on remedies.
36	The fraternities and sororities participating in this program shall

1	have no recourse against the Department of Finance and Administration if any
2	special African-American fraternity or sorority license plate is erroneously
3	issued or renewed without payment of the design use authorization statement.
