21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 5, Chapter 64, Subchapter 7 is amended  
24 to add an additional section to read as follows:

25 5-64-711. Cleanup of methamphetamine laboratories.

26 (a) The General Assembly finds that:

27 (1) Many states throughout the nation have set standards for the  
28 cleanup of methamphetamine laboratories; and

29 (2) The State of Arkansas has not set standards for the cleanup  
30 of clandestine methamphetamine laboratories that can be used by local  
31 governments and circuit courts in nuisance abatement cases.

32 (b)(1) The Department of Health shall develop standards for the  
33 cleanup of methamphetamine laboratories.

34 (2) The standards shall be effective beginning on October 1,  
35 2003.
