20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 *SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 16-10-308 is amended to read as follows:*
23 *16-10-308. City administration of justice fund.*

24 *(a) There is hereby created in each municipality which operates a*
25 *police, city, or municipal court a fund in the office of the city treasurer*
26 *to be known as the "city administration of justice fund".*

27 *(b) The city administration of justice fund shall be used to defray a*
28 *part of the expense of the administration of justice in the city. From the*
29 *fund, the city shall continue to finance the following city agencies and*
30 *programs which are currently funded, in whole or in part, by filing fees*
31 *and/or court costs, at a funding level equal to not less than the greater of*
32 *the amount which was collected by the city from court costs and/or filing*
33 *fees for the agency or program in the calendar year ending December 31, 1994,*
34 *or the amount appropriated by ordinance enacted prior to December 31, 1994,*
35 *to the agency or program for the calendar year ending December 31, 1995:*

36 *(1) The municipal court judge and clerk retirement fund;*



- 1 (2) *The police and fire pension fund;*
2 (3) *The intoxication detection equipment fund;*
3 (4) *All municipal-level programs and agencies funded in whole or*
4 *in part by court costs and filing fees assessed and collected by the*

6 *laws authorizing the collection of court costs and filing fees; and*
7 (5) *All county-level programs and agencies funded in whole or in*

15 *calendar year ending December 31, 1994, or the amount appropriated from court*
16 *costs and filing fees by ordinance enacted prior to December 31, 1994, for*
17 *city or county administration of justice expense from court costs and filing*
18 *fees for the calendar year ending December 31, 1995, plus, for calendar years*
19 *1995 - 2001, an additional amount based upon the average percentage increase*
20 *in the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers or its successor, as*
21 *published by the United States Department of Labor for the two (2) years*
22 *immediately preceding.*
- 23 (B) *The amount retained during calendar year 2002 and each*
24 *calendar year thereafter shall be the amount retained during calendar year*
25 *2001.*
- 26 (2) *For the calendar year beginning January 1, 1998, the base*
27 *amount to be retained shall be:*
- 28 (A) *Increased by any increase in the Consumer Price Index,*
29 *as provided for in subdivision (c)(1) of this section;*
- 30 (B) *Decreased by eighty-five percent (85%) of the total*
31 *dollar amount which was certified by the city as having been collected during*
32 *calendar year 1994 for the purpose of funding the office and operation of the*
33 *public defender and public defender investigator.*
- 34 (d) *Nothing in this act shall prevent the city from funding any*
35 *additional costs for the administration of justice from other city funds.*
- 36 ~~(e) *The city shall, on or before the tenth day of November, 1995, and*~~

~~on or before the tenth day of each month thereafter, remit all sums received in excess of the amounts necessary to fund the expenses enumerated in subsections (b) and (c) of this section during the previous month from the uniform filing fees provided for in §§ 16-10-303 and 16-17-705 and the uniform court costs provided for in § 16-10-305 to the Department of Finance and Administration, Administration of Justice Funds Section, for deposit in the State Administration of Justice Fund.~~

(e) The following cities shall, on or before the tenth day of August 2003, and on or before the tenth day of each month thereafter, remit the following sums by paying one-twelfth (1/12) each month of the amount, to reimburse the general fund of the State of Arkansas a portion of the salaries paid to the judges of the district courts of the state, from the uniform filing fees provided for in §§ 16-10-303 and 16-17-705 and the uniform court costs provided for in § 16-10-305 to the Department of Finance and Administration, for deposit in the Constitutional Officer Fund of the State of Arkansas:
