## For An Act To Be Entitled

## Subtitle

AN ACT TO PROHIBIT A CITY OR TOWN FROM REQUIRING LANDSCAPE DESIGNERS TO HAVE A LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT LICENSE IN ORDER TO RECEIVE A LANDSCAPE PERMIT.

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 14, Chapter, 56, Subchapter 1 is amended to add an additional section as follows:

14-56-102. Landscape Permits.
(a)(1) No city or town shall require a landscape designer to have a landscape architect license in order to receive a landscape permit.
(2) If a city or town requires a landscape plan as a condition for the issuance of a landscape permit, the city or town shall not require a landscape plan submitted by a landscape designer to be approved by a licensed landscape architect.
(b) For the purposes of this section, "landscape designer" means a person who:
(1) Makes plans or drawings for the selection, placement, or use of plans when the execution of the plans or drawings does not affect public health, safety, or welfare; and
