23	(a)(1) $\underline{(A)}$ No student or postsecondary institution shall use public			
24	funds in a student aid package which exceeds the recognized cost of			
25	attendance the cost of tuition, fees, books, room, and board at the			
26	institution where the student enrolls.			
27	(B) If a student lives off campus, the institution shall			
28	calculate a room and board charge using federal guidelines.			
29	(2) Public funds are defined to include Department of Higher			
30	Education scholarships and grants, state general revenues, tuition, or local			
31	tax revenue.			
32	(b) All postsecondary institutions shall report to the department the			
33	total amount of financial aid from <del>all sources</del> <u>each source</u> for any student
