- 10 (B) The Governor shall appoint all seven (7) members of 11 the board of trustees.
- (C) Members of the board appointed by the Governor under the provisions of this section, in addition to possessing the qualifications of an elector, shall reside in the State of Arkansas.
- 15 (2)(A) Five (5) Six (6) ex officio nonvoting members shall also 16 serve on the board.
- 17 (B) The Director of the Department of Education, the
 18 Director of the Department of Higher Education, the President of the Arkansas
 19 Science and Technology Authority, the Director of the Department of Arkansas

16	may be removed by the board or the Governor.		
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18	SECTION 7. Arkansas Code \S 6-42-204(b)(3), pertaining to the Arkansas		
19	School for Mathematics and Sciences, is amended to read as follows:		
20	(3) The administrator and other personnel employed for the		
21	operation of the school shall be employees of the State of Arkansas and shall		
22	not be deemed to be faculty or employees of the University of Arkansas.		
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24	SECTION 8. Arkansas Code § 6-42-206 is repealed.

26	All Department of Education regulations shall apply to the Arkansas

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30	SECTION 9. (a) The Arkansas School for Mathematics and Sciences
