to transfer all funds, appropriations, credits, and equities belonging to the 1 2 Arkansas School for Mathematics and Sciences and its board of trustees so 3 that the same shall be credited to and made available for the Board of Trustees of the University of Arkansas for use on its Arkansas School for 4 5 Mathematics, Sciences, and the Arts campus. 6 (d) The Board of Trustees of the Arkansas School for Mathematics and 7 Sciences shall, on January 1, 2004, relinquish all responsibility, control, 8 and supervision concerning the Arkansas School for Mathematics and Sciences, 9 and by delivery of the assets, books of accounts, and files of that 10 institution to the Board of Trustees of the University of Arkansas shall be 11 divested of all obligations and duties applicable to the Arkansas School for 12 Mathematics and Sciences. 13 14 SECTION 2. Purpose - Location - Funding - Tuition. 15 (a) The Arkansas School for Mathematics, Sciences, and the Arts shall 16 be a residential school for eleventh and twelfth grade students who exhibit 17 outstanding academic credentials and who have the ability to undertake course work in an environment and with demands similar to those of a university. 18 19 (b)(1) The purposes of the school shall be to educate the gifted and 20 talented math, science, and fine and performing arts students of the state 21 and to develop curricula and materials to improve instruction in mathematics, 22 sciences, and fine and performing arts for all students in the state. 23 (2) The school's curriculum, faculty, and admissions policies 24 shall reflect the purposes described by this act. 25 (c) While the emphasis of the school shall be dedicated to the academic teaching of mathematics, sciences, and fine and performing arts, 26 27 emphasis may also be placed upon other areas of the arts and humanities as 28 deemed appropriate by the Board of Trustees of the University of Arkansas. 29 (d) The board of trustees shall maintain the Arkansas School for 30 Mathematics, Sciences and the Arts in Hot Springs as a campus of the University of Arkansas offering at that location the highest possible quality 31 32 of educational programs as set forth in this act. 33 34 SECTION 3. Board of Visitors. 35 (a)(1) There is established a Board of Visitors for the Arkansas

School for Mathematics, Sciences, and the Arts.

1	(2) The persons serving on December 31, 2003 as members of the
2	Board of Trustees of the Arkansas School for Mathematics and Sciences shall
3	be members of the Board of Visitors for the Arkansas School for Mathematics,
4	Sciences, and the Arts and shall continue to serve for a term equal to the
5	unexpired portion of his or her term as a member of the Board of Trustees of

7	(3) The board of visitors shall consist of seven (7) members

12	(5) Appointments shall be for terms of seven (7) years or for
13	the remaining portion of an unexpired term.
14	(b)(1) Members of the board of visitors appointed by the Governor, in
15	addition to possessing the qualifications of an elector, shall reside in the
16	State of Arkansas.
17	(2) One (1) member shall be appointed from each congressional
18	district and the remaining members shall be appointed from the state at
19	large.
20	(3) In addition to appointed members of the board of visitors,
21	six (6) ex-officio non-voting members shall also serve on the board as
22	<u>follows:</u>
23	(A) The Director of the Department of Education;
24	(B) The Director of the Department of Higher Education;

T	SECTION 4. Board of Visitors - Purposes.
2	(a)(1) The general purpose of the Board of Visitors for the Arkansas
3	School for Mathematics, Sciences, and the Arts is to perform a liaison
4	function between the school, parents, and other constituents, through the
5	administrator of the school and the Board of Trustees of the University of
6	Arkansas.
7	(2) The board of visitors shall assist in securing financial
8	support for the institution, advise the administrator and the President and
9	the Board of Trustees of the University of Arkansas as to the educational and
10	service needs of the school, to aid in the orderly transition of the school
11	as it becomes a campus of the University of Arkansas, and to furnish counsel
12	and guidance, by advice and recommendations, for the school and its
13	administrator.
14	(3) Without limiting the generality of the purposes described in
15	this section, the board of visitors shall:
16	(A) Give detailed study to reports and issues placed
17	before it by the administrator of the school;
18	(B) Formulate and transmit to the administrator its advice
19	and recommendations on any matter of importance to the students, parents, or
20	other constituents of the school;
21	(C) Keep informed on such matters as are necessary to
22	promote the educational aims of the school for the benefit of the student;
23	(D) Study plans submitted by the administrator for
24	furthering the growth and insuring the quality of the school;
25	(E) Transmit their views for consideration by the
26	administrator and the President and the Board of Trustees of the University
27	of Arkansas;
28	(F) Participate in securing the continued financial
29	support for the school;
30	(G) Accept and execute specific assignments made by the
31	Board of Trustees of the University of Arkansas and the President of the
32	University of Arkansas;
33	(H) Review and provide recommendations to the
34	administrator regarding the school's operating budget priorities; and
35	(I) Promote, in diverse ways, the growth and development
36	in excellence of the school and the University of Arkansas in general.

1	(4) Communications, including advice and recommendations, from
2	the board of visitors shall be transmitted through the administrator of the
3	school and by him or her through the President of the University of Arkansas
4	to the Board of Trustees of the University of Arkansas.
5	(b) The school shall be funded by monies appropriated by the General
6	Assembly for the operation of the school and by grants, contributions, or
7	donations which may be received for the support of the school.
8	(c) Students selected to attend the school shall not be required to
9	pay tuition, fees, or room and board.
10	(d) Any student who is a senior at the school shall have the option of
11	participating in activities and events with, and in the same manner as, other
12	members of the graduating class in his or her home school district,
13	including, but not limited to, the following:
14	(1) The prom or banquet;
15	(2) Class day activities;
16	(3) Graduation activities;
17	(4) Recognition as a honor graduate, except as valedictorian or
18	salutatorian; and
19	(5) Class pictures, including yearbook and composite pictures.
20	
21	SECTION 5. Administrator—Staff.
22	(a)(1) The Administrator of the Arkansas School for Mathematics,
23	Sciences, and the Arts shall be the chief administrative officer of the
24	school and shall administer the school in accordance with policies
25	established by the Board of Trustees of the University of Arkansas.
26	(2) The administrator shall be employed by the board of trustees
27	after appropriate advice and counsel of the Board of Visitors of the Arkansas
28	School for Mathematics, Sciences, and the Arts.
29	(b) Upon recommendation of the administrator, the board of trustees
30	shall employ such other personnel as it deems necessary for the operation of
31	the school.
32	(c)(1) Instructors shall be employed by the board of trustees and
33	shall have such rights, privileges, and obligations as the board of trustees
34	shall determine, provided that they shall not be eligible for tenure nor
35	carry professional rank.
36	(2) In the event policies of the board of trustees conflict with

1	existing law with respect to terms and conditions of employment of
2	instructors and staff the policies shall control.
3	(d) Instructors and staff of the school shall continue to be eligible
4	for membership in the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System and earn credited
5	service for employment at the school or at their election shall be eligible
6	to participate in the retirement system of the University of Arkansas.
7	
8	SECTION 6. Department of Education regulations.
9	All Department of Education regulations shall apply to the Arkansas
10	School for Mathematics, Sciences, and the Arts unless the department
11	determines otherwise or unless the regulations conflict with governance of
12	the school by the Board of Trustees of the University of Arkansas and the
13	purposes and intent of this act.
14	
15	SECTION 7. Effective January 1, 2004, Arkansas Code §§ 6-42-201
16	through 6-42-206 are repealed.
17	6-42-201. Establishment - Purpose - Location - Funding - Tuition.
18	(a) There is hereby established the Arkansas School for Mathematics
19	and Sciences, hereinafter "school", which shall be a residential school for
20	eleventh and twelfth grade students.
21	(b)(1) The purposes of the school shall be to educate the gifted and
22	talented math and science students of the state and to develop curricula and
23	materials to improve instruction in mathematics and sciences for all students
24	in the state. The school's curriculum, faculty, and admissions policy shall
25	reflect those purposes.
26	(2) While the emphasis of the school shall be dedicated to the
27	academic teaching of mathematics and sciences, some emphasis may be placed on
28	the arts and humanities as deemed appropriate by the board of trustees.
29	(c) The school shall be located on the campus of an Arkansas
30	institution of higher education or at some other appropriate facility which
31	can provide the classrooms, laboratories, library facilities, dormitories,
32	and other services necessary for the proper operation and support of the
33	school.
34	(d)(1) The school shall be funded by moneys appropriated by the
35	General Assembly for the operation of the school and by grants,
36	contributions, or donations which may be received for the support of the

1	school.
2	(2) Students selected to attend the school shall not be required
3	to pay tuition, fees, or room and board.
4	(e) Any student who is a senior at the school shall have the option of
5	participating in activities and events with and in the same manner as other
6	members of the graduating class in his or her home school district, including
7	but not limited to the following:
8	(1) The prom or banquet;
9	(2) Glass Day activities;
10	(3) Graduation activities;
11	(4) Recognition as an honor graduate, except as valedictorian or

15	6-42-202. Board of trustees.
16	(a) The school shall be governed by a board of trustees.
17	$(b)(1)(\Lambda)$ The board of trustees shall consist of seven (7) members,
18	with one (1) member appointed from each congressional district and the
19	remaining members appointed at large.
20	(B) The Governor shall appoint all seven (7) members of
21	the board of trustees.
22	(C) Members of the board appointed by the Governor under
23	the provisions of this section, in addition to possessing the qualifications
24	of an elector, shall reside in the State of Arkansas.
25	(2)(A) Five (5) ex officio nonvoting members shall also serve on
26	the board.

34	6-42-203. Powers and duties of the board of trustees.
35	(a) The board of trustees created under § 6-42-202 is charged with the
36	management and control of the Arkansas School for Mathematics and Sciences.

1	(b) The board shall annually elect a chairman, a secretary, and such
2	other officers as the board deems appropriate.
3	(c)(1) The board shall meet at least once a month.
4	(2) The chairman is authorized to call special meetings of the
5	board as needed upon two (2) days' written notice to the members.
6	(3) Any three (3) board members are authorized to call special
7	meetings of the board upon two (2) days' written notice to the members.
8	(d)(1) The board shall employ an administrator for the school, who may
9	be removed by the board or the Governor.
10	(2) The Governor may designate the Director of the Department of
11	Education to act in his stead.
12	(e) The board is authorized to contract with other state agencies and
13	private research centers as it deems necessary in carrying out its
14	responsibilities for the operation of the school.
15	(f) The board is authorized to receive contributions, donations,
16	gifts, bequests of money, other forms of financial assistance, and property,
17	equipment, materials, or personnel from persons, foundations, trust funds,
18	corporations, organizations, and other sources, private or public, to be
19	expended and utilized for the operation of the school.
20	(g) The members of the board may receive expense reimbursement in
21	accordance with § 25-16-901 et seq.
22	
23	6-42-204. Administrator - Staff.
24	(a) The administrator of the Arkansas School for Mathematics and
25	Sciences shall be the chief administrative officer of the school and shall
26	administer the school in accordance with policies established by the board of
27	trustees.
28	(b)(1) Upon recommendation of the administrator, the board shall
29	employ other personnel the board deems necessary for the operation of the
30	school.
31	(2) Faculty members and other personnel required for operation
32	of the school shall be recommended for employment by the administrator and
33	shall be employed by annual contract by the school.
34	(3) The administrator and other personnel employed for the
35	operation of the school shall be employees of the State of Arkansas.
36	(c)(l) Teachers and administrators so employed shall be eligible for

1	membership in the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System and earn credited
2	service for such employment.
3	(2) Noneducational personnel employed by the department shall be
4	eligible for membership in the system and earn credit for such employment.
5	
6	6-42-205. Technical assistance from state agencies.
7	The Department of Education, the Department of Higher Education, and
8	the Arkansas Science and Technology Authority shall provide technical
9	assistance to the staff of the Arkansas School for Mathematics and Sciences.
10	
11	6-42-206. Governance of school.
12	All Department of Education regulations shall apply to the Arkansas
13	School for Mathematics and Sciences unless the department indicates
14	otherwise.
