19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Purpose.

22 (a) For purposes of the 2004 general election and elections
23 thereafter, the State of Arkansas shall retain the current six (6) districts
24 for the election of judges to the Arkansas Court of Appeals.

25 (b) It is the purpose of this act to provide that the six (6)
26 electoral districts for the Arkansas Court of Appeals shall remain the same
27 as now established by law and to establish the dates for election of the two
28 (2) judges within each of those districts.
