10 MODIFY ITS REQUIREMENTS TO ALLOW A HIGH SCHOOL

12 ONE CORE COURSE WHEN A STUDENT EARNED CREDIT FOR
13 THE COURSE, BUT EARNED A BELOW AVERAGE GRADE AND
14 THE STUDENT REPEATS THE COURSE AND EARNS A GRADE
15 HIGHER THAN BELOW AVERAGE; AND FOR OTHER
16 PURPOSES.

26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

28 SECTION 1. (a) Before July 1, 2004, the Department of Education shall
29 adopt regulations to allow a high school student to earn an elective credit
30 by repeating a course provided that:

31 (1) The student earned credit for the course the first time the
32 student took the course;

33 (2) The student earned a below average grade the first time the
34 student took the course;

35 (3) The student earned a higher grade when the course was
36 repeated; and
