23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

25 SECTION 1. When passing a law enforcement officer stopped on the
26 shoulder of a multi-lane highway, with the patrol car's lights flashing, the
27 motor vehicle operator shall move into the outside lane and remain in that
28 lane until they have passed the law enforcement officer's vehicle and any
29 other vehicles involved in the stop.
