15 AN ACT TO REQUIRE PERSONS WHO HAVE FILED  
16 BANKRUPTCY TO DISCLOSE THAT FACT WHEN  
17 SEEKING THE EXTENSION OF CREDIT.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
21

22 SECTION 1. (a)(1) Any person who has filed a petition for bankruptcy  
23 or has had an involuntary bankruptcy petition filed against him or her, shall  
24 disclose that fact in writing, until discharged by the bankruptcy court, to  
25 any person, firm, company, association, partnership, corporation, or other  
26 business entity from which the person seeks the extension of credit for the  
27 purchase of goods or services.

28 (2) Any persons who violates subsection (a)(1) of this section  
29 is guilty of a Class A misdemeanor.

30 (b) This act shall not apply when the person is seeking emergency  
31 medical care from an emergency medical provider as defined under the  
32 "Definition of Emergency Medical Care Act", Arkansas Code § 20-9-309.
