## Subtitle

AN ACT TO RESTRUCTURE THE ARKANSAS
MINORITY HEALTH COMMISSION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 20-2-102(a), concerning the membership of the Arkansas Minority Health Commission, is amended to read as follows:

20-2-102. Creation - Members - Compensation.
(a) There is established the Arkansas Minority Health Commission to consist of twelve (12) members to be appointed as follows:
(1) Foux (4) Eight (8) of the general public to be appointed by the Governor, with each of the four (4) congressional districts represented by two (2) members;
(2) Two (2) members to be appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate; and
(3) Two (2) members to be appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives;
(4) The Director of the Bureau of Alcohol and Drug Abuse

Prevention or his designee;
(5) The Director of the Division of Aging and Adult Services of the Department of Human Sexvices or his designee;
(6) The Director of the Department of Health or his designee;
and
(7) The Director of the Division of Mental Health Services of the Department of Human Services or his designee.
