13 JOINING WOMEN WORLDWIDE IN CELEBRATING
14 MARCH 8 AS INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S DAY.

16 WHEREAS, March 8 is recognized worldwide as International Women's Day;
17 and

19 WHEREAS, this date is also commemorated at the United Nations and is
20 designated in many countries as a national holiday; and

22 WHEREAS, when women on all continents, often divided by national
23 boundaries and by ethnic, linguistic, cultural, economic, and political
24 differences, come together to celebrate their day, they can look back to a
25 tradition that represents at least nine decades of struggle for equality,
26 justice, peace, and development; and

28 WHEREAS, International Women's Day is the story of ordinary women as
29 makers of history and it is rooted in the centuries-old struggle of women to
30 participate in society on an equal footing with men; and

32 WHEREAS, in ancient Greece, Lysistrata initiated a sexual strike
33 against men in order to end war, and during the French Revolution, Parisian
34 women calling for "liberty, equality, fraternity" marched on Versailles to
35 demand women's suffrage; and

1 WHEREAS, the idea of an International Women’s Day first arose at the
2 turn of the century, which in the industrialized world was a period of
3 expansion and turbulence, booming population growth, and radical ideologies,

5 NOW THEREFORE,

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE EIGHTY-FOURTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE
7 STATE OF ARKANSAS:
