10 ADDITIONAL SUPPORT FOR THE SCHOOL OF AGRICULTURE,
11 AQUACULTURE/FISHERIES, HUMAN SCIENCES RESEARCH
12 AND EXTENSION PROGRAMS IN ORDER TO MATCH FEDERAL
13 FUNDS FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS AT PINE
14 BLUFF; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

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18 AN ACT FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS
19 AT PINE BLUFF - THE SCHOOL OF
20 AGRICULTURE, AQUACULTURE/FISHERIES,
21 HUMAN SCIENCES RESEARCH AND EXTENSION
22 PROGRAMS GENERAL IMPROVEMENT
23 APPROPRIATION.
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26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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28 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS - AGRICULTURE, AQUACULTURE/FISHERIES, HUMAN
29 SCIENCES RESEARCH AND EXTENSION PROGRAMS. There is hereby appropriated, to
30 the University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff, to be payable from the University
31 of Arkansas at Pine Bluff Fund, the following:

32 (A) For providing additional support for the Agriculture,
33 Aquaculture/Fisheries, Human Sciences Research and Extension Programs, the
34 sum of\$1,073,000.
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36 SECTION 2. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE



1 NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND TRANSFER.
2 Immediately upon the effective date of this act the Chief Fiscal Officer of
3 the State shall transfer on his books and those of the State Treasurer and
4 Auditor of State the sum of one million seventy-three thousand dollars
5 (\$1,073,000) from the General Improvement Fund to the University of Arkansas
6 at Pine Bluff Fund.

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8 SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
9 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
10 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
11 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
12 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
13 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures
14 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this
15 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of
16 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied
17 with in disbursement of said funds.

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19 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
20 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
21 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
22 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
23 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
24 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
25 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
26 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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28 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
29 Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of
30 the University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff are, due to unforeseen
31 circumstances, insufficient for the University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff to
32 continue to provide essential governmental services; that the provisions of
33 this act will provide the necessary monies for the University of Arkansas at
34 Pine Bluff to continue such services; and that a delay in the effective date
35 of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and
36 provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is

1 hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate
2 preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force
3 and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.

4 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become
5 effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor
6 may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
7 overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides
8 the veto.
