- 1 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY
- 2 FORWARD COMMERCIAL DRIVERS LICENSE PROGRAM. The unexpended balances in the
- 3 appropriations provided in Item (04) of for Ledbetter Building Infrastructure
- 4 in Section 7 remaining on June 30, 2002 June 30, 2004, may be carried forward
- 5 and used for the same purpose during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2003
- 6 June 30, 2005. The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from

- 9 SECTION 19. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

- 11 BALANCES. COMMERCIAL DRIVER LICENSE FUND (A) For all appropriations as

- 14 proposed expenditures would cause the COMMERCIAL DRIVER LICENSE FUND to

- dollars (\$1,129,600) a fund balance to decline to less than fifty percent

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If it has been determined by the Director of the Department of Finance and Administration that the Department cannot continue a contract with a private provider and the Director deems it necessary to utilize Department staff to provide the required services, the Department is allowed, after seeking prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, to utilize the contingent positions for data entry contained in Section 20 of this Act and make the appropriate transfers from the various Maintenance and Operations, Professional Fees and Services or Data Processing line items contained in Section 4 of this Act to Regular Salaries and Personal Services Matching.

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SECTION 21. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal

1	control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
2	the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
3	strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.
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5	SECTION 22. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
6	that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
7	in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
8	was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
9	and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
10	the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
11	testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
12	Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
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14	SECTION 23. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
15	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
16	appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
17	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of
18	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
19	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
20	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the
21	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
22	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
23	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
24	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2003.
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
