16	SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS		
17	CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.		
18	PRIORITIES. A high priority of the Southeast Arkansas College shall be to		
19	combat illiteracy and to provide industrial training in the work place.		
20	The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from $\frac{\text{July 1, 2001}}{\text{July 1, 2001}}$

23	SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS		
24	CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND		
25	BALANCES. The Board of Trustees in its official governing capacity charged		
26	with the management or control of the institution of higher learning and the		
27	President or Chancellor as the Chief Executive shall certify to the Chief		
28	Fiscal Officer of the State and the Legislative Council that as of December		
29	31 of each year that sufficient appropriations and funds are available, or		
30	will become available, to meet all current and anticipated obligations during		
31	the fiscal year for the payment of the obligations when they become due.		
32	This certification, signed by the Chair of the Board of Trustees and the		
33	President or Chancellor will be forwarded by February 28 of each year or upon		
34	release of the previous year's audit by Legislative Audit to the Chief Fiscal		
35	Officer of the State and the Legislative Council accompanied by the Board		
36	approved published annual financial statement for the preceding fiscal year.		

1 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003 2 through June 30, 2005. 3 SECTION 8. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 4 5 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 6 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and 7 8 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 9 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures 10 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this 11 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of 12 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied 13 with in disbursement of said funds. 14 15 SECTION 9. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 16 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 17 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 18 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 19 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 20 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 21 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 22 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 2.3 24 SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 25 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 26 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the 27 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of 28 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 29 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective 30 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. 31 32 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being 33 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and 34 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2003.

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
