15 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION
16 - ARKANSAS SCHOOL FOR MATHEMATICS AND
17 SCIENCES APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2003-2005
18 BIENNIUM.
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22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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24 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
25 Department of Education - Arkansas School for Mathematics and Sciences for
26 the 2003-2005 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees
27 whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform
28 Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or
29 its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any
30 position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in
31 dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification
32 and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are
33 hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and
34 Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

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34 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Department of
 35 Education - Arkansas School for Mathematics and Sciences for the 2003-2005
 36 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees,

1 to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such
 2 purposes: five (5) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates
 3 of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and
 4 Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate
 5 classification.

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 7 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department
 8 of Education, to be payable from the Department of Education Public School
 9 Fund Account, for personal services and operating expenses of the Department
 10 of Education - School for Mathematics and Sciences for the biennial period
 11 ending June 30, 2005, the following:

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 26 SECTION 4. REGULAR SALARIES - DISTANCE LEARNING PROGRAM - CASH. There is
 27 hereby established for the Department of Education - School for Mathematics
 28 and Sciences - Distance Learning Program for the 2003-2005 biennium, the
 29 following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be
 30 governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act
 31 (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory
 32 thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum
 33 annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the
 34 provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons
 35 occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions
 36 of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-

SECTION 5. APPROPRIATION - DISTANCE LEARNING PROGRAM - CASH. SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SUMMER SCHOOL EMPLOYEES. Employees who, in addition to working during the regular school term also work during the summer months, shall be authorized as additional compensation an amount not to exceed 1/12 of their annual salary for each month or part thereof worked. Such additional compensation shall not be construed as exceeding the maximum salary authorized for said employees. Payment of additional compensation shall be limited to employees

8 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from ~~July 1, 2001~~
9 July 1, 2003 through ~~June 30, 2003~~ June 30, 2005.

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11 SECTION 7. APPROPRIATION. GENERAL IMPROVEMENT - ARKANSAS SCHOOL FOR
12 MATHEMATICS AND SCIENCES. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas
13 School for Mathematics and Sciences, to be payable from the General
14 Improvement Fund, or its successor fund or fund accounts, for costs
15 associated with construction, renovation, major maintenance, and purchase,
16 upgrade and installation of equipment, for each fiscal year of the biennial
17 period ending June 30, 2005, the sum of \$250,000.

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19 SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
20 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TEACHER
21 GRANT RELATED FUNDING PROVISION. Teachers of the School for Mathematics and
22 Sciences who, in addition to fulfilling annual teaching contract requirements
23 also write grants, grant progress reports and write and publish papers may be
24 authorized as additional annual compensation an amount up to 1/12 of their
25 annual salary. Such additional compensation shall not be construed as
26 exceeding the maximum salary authorized for said employees. The additional
27 compensation authorized by this section shall only be paid from a portion of
28 the grant monies received and shall not be paid from state general revenues
29 or Educational Excellence Trust Fund monies.

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31 SECTION 9. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
32 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
33 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
34 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
35 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
36 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal

1 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
2 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
3 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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5 SECTION 10. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
6 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
7 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
8 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
9 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
10 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
11 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
12 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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14 SECTION 11. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
15 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
16 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
17 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of
18 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
19 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
20 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the
21 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
22 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
23 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
24 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2003.
