SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 12 13 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND 14 BALANCES. The Board of Trustees in its official governing capacity charged 15 with the management or control of the institution of higher learning and the 16 President or Chancellor as the Chief Executive shall certify to the Chief 17 Fiscal Officer of the State and the Legislative Council that as of December 18 31 of each year that sufficient appropriations and funds are available, or 19 will become available, to meet all current and anticipated obligations during the fiscal year for the payment of the obligations when they become due. 20 21 This certification, signed by the Chair of the Board of Trustees and the 22 President or Chancellor will be forwarded by February 28 of each year or upon 23 release of the previous year's audit by Legislative Audit to the Chief Fiscal 24 Officer of the State and the Legislative Council accompanied by the Board 25 approved published annual financial statement for the preceding fiscal year. 26 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003 27 through June 30, 2005.

29 SECTION 8. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 30 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 31 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 32 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and 33 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 34 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this 35 36 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of

Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied
 with in disbursement of said funds.

3 4 SECTION 9. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 5 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 6 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 7 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 8 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 9 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 10 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 11 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 12 13 SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 14 15 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the 16 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of 17 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective 18 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the 19 20 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. 21 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being 22 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and 23 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2003. 24 25 26 27 2.8 29 30 31 32 33 34 35 36
