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28	SECTION 1. Ark	ansas Code § 6-11-101 is amended to read as fo	llows:

4	(A) Upon the expiration of the terms of two (2) board		
5	members in the year 1999, there shall be an appointment of one (1) member;		
6	(B) Upon the expiration of the terms of two (2) board		
7	members in the year 2000, there shall be an appointment of one (1) member;

9	(C) Upon the expiration of the terms of two (2) board		
10	members in the year 2001, there shall be an appointment of one (1) member.		
11	(3) The members of the State Board shall be appointed as		
12	<u>follows:</u>		
13	(A) Four (4) persons appointed by the Governor;		
14	(B) One (1) person appointed by the Lieutenant Governor;		
15	(C) Two (2) persons appointed by the President Pro Tempore		
16	of the Senate; and		
17	(D) Two (2) persons appointed by the Speaker of the House		
18	of Representatives.		
19	(4) The Governor, President Pro Tempore of the Senate, and the		
20	Speaker of the House of Representatives shall draw lots to determine from		
21	which congressional district each officer will make his or her appointments		
22	and the Lieutenant Governor shall make the appointment for the at-large		
23	position.		
24	(b) (1) The term of office of a member of the board shall be six (6)		
25	years. Upon taking office in 2004, the members shall draw lots to determine		
26	the length of their initial terms.		
27	(2) The initial terms of office shall be staggered terms as		
28	<u>follows:</u>		
29	(A) One (1) member appointed by the President Pro Tempore		
30	of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and the Governor		
31	shall have an initial term that expires on July 1, 2006;		
32	(B) One (1) member appointed by the Lieutenant Governor,		
33	the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and the Governor shall have an		
34	initial term that expires on July 1, 2008; and		
35	(C) One (1) member appointed by the President Pro Tempore		
36	of the Senate and two (2) persons appointed by the Governor shall have an		

- 1 initial term that expires on July 1, 2010. 2 (3) Subsequent appointments shall be for a term of six (6) 3 years. 4 The membership of the board shall reflect the diversity in general 5 education. 6 (d)(1) No person may serve as a member of the board unless he or she 7 is a qualified elector and is a person of high moral standards and recognized 8 ability. 9 (2) Neither the Director of the Department of Education nor any 10 candidate for public office, holder of a public office in the state, 11 schoolteacher, county or city superintendent, employee of a state-supported 12 college or university, or member of any board of trustees of any state institution of higher learning shall serve as a member of the board. 13 14 (e) The members of the board shall be appointed by the Governor, 15 subject to the confirmation of the Senate, and shall take the oath of office 16 for officers prescribed by the Constitution. 17 (f)(1)(A) When a vacancy occurs in the membership of the board, the 18 Governor shall appoint a successor to the person who has vacated the 19 membership, who will the vacancy shall be filled in the same manner and from 20 the same congressional district as the original appointment. 21 (B) If the original appointment was for an at-large 22 position, the vacancy shall be filled in the same manner as the original 23 appointment and shall continue to be an at-large position. 24 (C) The person appointed shall serve the unexpired term of 25 the person succeeded, subject to all other provisions of this section. 26 (2) Resignation, removal from the district from which he or she 27 is appointed, disqualification, incapacitation from mental or physical 28 disability or otherwise, or change in status from the eligibility 29 requirements for membership on the board shall automatically create a vacancy 30 in the membership of the board, and no such member shall thereafter exercise any of the functions of membership on the board even though his or her 31
  - (g)(1) Members of the board shall be subject to removal from office by the Governor when the actions or condition of a member shall be considered as sufficient cause for removal.
- 36 (2) However, before a member may be removed for cause, this

successor has not been appointed.

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- 1 cause must have been accepted as true, good, and sufficient by a majority 2 written vote of all members of the board after a formal hearing at a regular 3 or special session of the board. 4 (h)(g) The members of the board shall serve without remuneration but 5 may receive expense reimbursement and stipends in accordance with § 25-16-901 6 et seq., as follows: 7 (1) Their actual expenses while attending regular and special 8 meetings of the board; and

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- 12 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-11-102(a), concerning the employment of 13 the Director of the Department of Education, is amended to read as follows:

  15 the State Board of Education is empowered to shall employ a person to act as
  16 the Director of the Department of Education, who shall serve at the pleasure
  17 of the Governor board.

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- 19 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 6-11-103 is amended to read as follows: 20 6-11-103. Officers.
  - (a) The State Board of Education shall have an organizational meeting on the second Monday in July 2004 and shall elect one (1) of its number chairman chairperson, one (1) vice chairman chairperson, and such other officers as the board deems necessary to perfect its organization.
  - (b) The Director of the Department of Education shall act as ex officio secretary of the board without vote.

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- SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 6-11-104 is amended to read as follows: 6-11-104. Meetings.
- 30 (a) Effective July 1, 2004, the State Board of Education shall meet a
  31 minimum of six (6) times annually no less than once per month.
- 32 (b) The board will During the organizational meeting in July 2004, the

- 36 (c)(1) Special meetings may be called by the chairman chairperson of

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     the Director of the Department of Education and with timely responses from

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     a quorum will be present.

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     the same notice and response requirements.
