1 (B) By December 31 of each calendar year thereafter, in 2 addition to the six (6) hours training requirement in subdivision (a)(1)(A) of this section, new members of a school district board of directors shall 3 4 also comply with all other training requirements contained in this section for a total of twelve (12) hours of training obtained between the time of 5 6 their election and the end of their first full calendar year of office and 7 six (6) hours each calendar year thereafter. 8 (C)(i) Beginning January 1, 2004, and every year 9 thereafter, all existing and re-elected board members shall obtain a minimum of six (6) hours training and instruction by December 31 of each calendar 10 11 year. 12 (ii) The training and instruction of board members 13 shall include topics relevant to school laws, school operations, and the powers, duties, and responsibilities of the members of the board of directors 14 15 including, but not limited to, legal requirements, role differentiation, 16 financial management, and improving student achievement. 17 (D) Hours of training and instruction obtained in excess of the minimum requirements may cumulate and be carried over from year to 18 19 year.
