24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

26 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 20-7-135(c) is amended to read as follows:

27 (c) Beginning with the 2003-2004 school year, every school district
28 shall:

29 (1) Prohibit for elementary school students in-school access to
30 vending machines offering food and beverages; and

31 (2) Require schools to include as part of the annual report to
32 parents and the community the amounts and specific sources of funds received
33 and expenditures made from competitive food and beverage contracts~~+~~.

34 (3) *Require schools to include as a part of ~~the~~ a student health*
35 *report ~~card~~ to parents an annual body mass index percentile by age for each*
36 *students;*

2 (4) Require schools to annually provide parents with an
3 explanation of the possible health effects of body mass index, nutrition, and
4 physical activity.
