BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 20-7-135(c) is amended to read as follows:

(c) Beginning with the 2003-2004 school year, every school district

28

shall:

(1) Prohibit for elementary school students in-school access to vending machines offering food and beverages; and

(2) Require schools to include as part of the annual report to parents and the community the amounts and specific sources of funds received and expenditures made from competitive food and beverage contracts~~+~~.

(3) *Require schools to include as a part of ~~the~~ a student health report ~~card~~ to parents an annual body mass index percentile by age for each*
