6-42-309. Charter school option.
The Board of Trustees of the University of Arkansas may petition the
State Board of Education for the Arkansas School for Mathematics, Sciences,
and the Arts to receive charter school status under the Arkansas Charter
Schools Act of 1999. If the petition is granted, funding for the charter
school shall be made pursuant to an appropriation by the General Assembly for
the Arkansas School for Mathematics, Sciences, and the Arts.
SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-23-103(8), concerning definitions used
for purposes of "The Arkansas Charter Schools Act of 1999", is amended to
read as follows:
(8) <u>(A)</u> "Public school" means a school that is part of a public
school district under the control and management of a local board.
(B) "Public school" includes the Arkansas School for
Mathematics, Sciences, and the Arts; and
SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the Arkansas Supreme Court in
Lake View District No. 25 v. Huckabee, 351 Ark 31 (2002) declared the
existing system of education to be unconstitutional because it is both
inequitable and inadequate; that this act assists the Arkansas School for
Mathematics, Sciences, and the Arts to be eligible for federal grants, and
allows the school the flexibility to become a charter school; and that this
act is immediately necessary to assist the Arkansas School for Mathematics,
Sciences, and the Arts. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and
this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public
peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:
(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;
(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,
the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the
bill; or
(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
