2	(3) A monthly allowance at the federal Internal Revenue Service

6	(c) The school board of any school district in a high-poverty area may	
7	reimburse at the federal Internal Revenue Service reimbursement rate for	
8	travel, as in effect on January 1, 2004, any person who interviews for	
9	employment as a licensed teacher with the district, for the mileage and other	
10	actual expenses incurred by the person in the course of travel to and from	
11	the interview.	
12	(d)(1) The state board shall promulgate rules to reimburse state-	
13	licensed teachers for the expense of moving if the employment necessitates	
14	the relocation of the teacher to a high-poverty area.	
15	(2) The expense reimbursement shall be allowed for both in-state	
16	and out-of-state teachers who enter into a contract for employment in \underline{a}	
17	school district situated in a high-poverty area.	
18	(3) To be eligible for the reimbursement, the teacher shall	
19	apply to the local district, and the district shall obtain approval from the	
20	Department of Education for reimbursement before the relocation occurs.	
21	(4)(A) If the reimbursement is approved, the department shall	
22	provide funds to the school district to reimburse the teacher in an amount	
23	not to exceed two thousand dollars (\$2,000) for the documented actual	
24	expenses incurred in the course of relocating.	
25	(B) Allowable expenses shall include:	
26	(i) The expense of any professional moving company	
27	or persons employed to assist with the move;	
28	(ii) Rented moving vehicles or equipment;	
29	(iii) Mileage in the amount authorized for state	
30	employees if the teacher used a personal vehicle or vehicles for the move;	
31	(iv) Meals; and	
32	(v) Other expenses associated with the relocation in	
33	accordance with the department's established rules and regulations.	
34	(5)(A) Nothing in this subsection (d) requires the actual	
35	residence to which the teacher relocates to be within the boundaries of the	
36	school district which has executed a contract for employment with the	

1	teacher, or within the boundaries of the area designated by the state board
2	as a high-poverty area for the teacher to be eligible for reimbursement for
3	moving expenses.
4	(B) However, to be reimbursed under this subsection (d),
5	teachers shall relocate within the State of Arkansas.
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
