For An Act To Be Entitled

9 AN ACT TO ENSURE THAT THE TEACHER DAILY PLANNING
10 PERIOD OCCURS DURING THE STUDENT INSTRUCTIONAL
11 DAY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

14 AN ACT TO ENSURE THAT THE TEACHER DAILY
15 PLANNING PERIOD OCCURS DURING THE
16 STUDENT INSTRUCTIONAL DAY.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-17-114(a)(2), concerning the daily
22 planning period for teachers, is amended to read as follows:

23 (2)(A) The planning time shall be in increments of no less than
24 forty (40) minutes during the student instructional day.

25 (B) A teacher who does not receive the planning time
26 required under subdivision (a)(2)(A) of this section within the student
27 instructional day shall be compensated at his or her hourly rate of pay for
28 each missed planning period.

29 (C) Teachers who have collectively negotiated a contract
30 through a local teacher's association are exempt from the provisions of this
31 subsection (a).

33 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-17-114, concerning the daily planning
34 period for teachers, is amended to read as follows:

35 (d) As used in this section, "student instructional day" means the
36 time that students are required to be present at school.
