## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO ENSURE THAT THE TEACHER DAILY PLANNING PERIOD OCCURS DURING THE STUDENT INSTRUCTIONAL DAY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

AN ACT TO ENSURE THAT THE TEACHER DAILY
PLANNING PERIOD OCCURS DURING THE STUDENT INSTRUCTIONAL DAY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-17-114(a)(2), concerning the daily planning period for teachers, is amended to read as follows:
(2)(A) The planning time shall be in increments of no less than forty (40) minutes during the student instructional day.
(B) A teacher who does not receive the planning time required under subdivision (a)(2)(A) of this section within the student instructional day shall be compensated at his or her hourly rate of pay for each missed planning period.
(C) Teachers who have collectively negotiated a contract through a local teacher's association are exempt from the provisions of this subsection (a).

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-17-114, concerning the daily planning period for teachers, is amended to read as follows:
(d) As used in this section, "student instructional day" means the

time that students are required to be present at school.

SECTION 3. This act shall be effective at the beginning of the 20042005 school year.
