15	AN ACT TO ENSURE THAT THE TEACHER DAILY
16	PLANNING PERIOD OCCURS DURING THE
17	STUDENT INSTRUCTIONAL DAY.

20	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
21	
22	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-17-114(a)(2), concerning the daily
23	planning period for teachers, is amended to read as follows:
24	(2)(A) The planning time shall be in increments of no less than
25	forty (40) minutes <u>during the student instructional day</u> .
26	(B) A teacher who does not receive the planning time
27	required under subdivision (a)(2)(A) of this section within the student
28	instructional day shall be compensated at his or her hourly rate of pay for
29	each missed planning period.
30	(C) A school district shall be exempt from the provisions
31	of this subdivision (a)(2)(A), if it:
32	(ii) Has collectively negotiated a contract through
33	a local teacher's association; and
34	(ii) The collectively negotiated contract expressly
35	provides for a teacher's daily planning period.
36	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-17-114, concerning the daily planning

1	period for teachers, is amended to read as follows:
2	(d) As used in this section, "student instructional day" means the
3	time that students are required to be present at school.
4	
5	SECTION 3. This act shall be effective at the beginning of the 2004-
6	2005 school year.
