AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE MEANING OF INSTRUCTIONAL DUTIES IN RELATION TO ASSIGNMENT OF NONINSTRUCTIONAL DUTIES TO TEACHERS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-17-117 is amended to read as follows: 6-17-117. Noninstructional duties.
(a)(l) The purpose of this section is to provide additional time for instructional purposes and to reduce the amount of time for noninstructional duties.
(2) Any teacher assigned more than sixty (60) minutes of noninstructional duties per week shall be contracted in accordance with § 6-17-807 (g) .
(b) For the purpose of this section, "noninstructional duty" means the supervision of students before or after the instructional day begins or ends for students or for the supervision of students during breakfasts, lunches, recesses, or scheduled breaks.
(c) For the purpose of this section, "instructional purposes" means activities initiated by the teacher related to teaching duties including, but

not limited to, contacting parents, assessing student performance,
documenting student performance, organizing the classroom, preparing
instructional materials, and other teaching responsibilities related to
instructional planning and the direct instruction of students.
