20	(1) "Praxis III" means the evaluation of classroom performance			
21	of a novice teacher by a trained assessor that utilizes a framework of			
22	essential teaching skills in which the novice teacher must demonstrate			
23	competency in an authentic classroom setting, the passing of which allows for			
24	conversion of an initial l	icense to a five-year standa	ard license; and	
25	(2) "Addition	al areas of licensure" means	areas of certification	
26	that require additional co	ollege courses in order to be	e certified in certain	
27	subject areas.			
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29	SECTION 2. <u>(a) By</u>	January 1, 2004, the Praxis	III assessment shall be	
30	eliminated as a requirement for teachers receiving a standard teacher			
31	license.			
32	(b)(1) By January 1, 2004, the Department of Education shall govern			
33	adding additional areas of licensure, including special education,			
34	administrators, counselors, and library or media.

1	(c)(l) Universities who have approved grades prekindergarten through		
2	four (preK-4) and grades four through eight (4-8) certification programs in

5	(2) Universities currently offering grades prekindergarten		
6	through four (preK-4) early childhood certification programs approved by the		
7	department shall not be required to resubmit these programs for approval when		
8	licensure level changes from prekindergarten through four (preK-4) to grades		
9	prekindergarten through six (preK-6).		
10	(d) Beginning January 1, 2004, the levels of licensure for Arkansas		
11	shall be for grades prekindergarten through six (preK-6) and grades seven
