## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT  
10 OF EDUCATION FOR AN OPERATING GRANT FOR THE  
11 ARKANSAS TEACHER HOUSING DEVELOPMENT FOUNDATION  
12 FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 2005; AND  
13 FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

16 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION -  
17 OPERATING GRANT FOR THE ARKANSAS TEACHER  
18 HOUSING DEVELOPMENT FOUNDATION.  
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22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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24 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - ARKANSAS TEACHER HOUSING DEVELOPMENT  
25 FOUNDATION. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Education, to  
26 *be payable from the Department of Education Public School Fund Account, to*  
27 *provide an Arkansas Teacher Housing Development Foundation for the biennial*  
28 *period ending June 30, 2005, the following:*

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35 SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized  
36 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds



1 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the  
2 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and  
3 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
4 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
5 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
6 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
7 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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9 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
10 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
11 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
12 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
13 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
14 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
15 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
16 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

17 **EMERGENCY CLAUSE FAILED TO PASS**

18 ~~SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General~~  
19 ~~Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the~~  
20 ~~appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the Arkansas~~  
21 ~~Supreme Court has ruled the current system of education in Arkansas is~~  
22 ~~inadequate and inequitable and has included as a basic component additional~~  
23 ~~support for teacher recruitment is necessary; that the Department of~~  
24 ~~Education through the Arkansas Teacher Housing Development Foundation needs~~  
25 ~~financial assistance to provide housing incentives to attract high performing~~  
26 ~~teachers to "high priority school districts"; that the effectiveness of this~~  
27 ~~Act on the date of its passage and approval is essential to the operation of~~  
28 ~~the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that~~  
29 ~~the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond the date of its passage~~  
30 ~~and approval could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and~~  
31 ~~provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is~~  
32 ~~hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate~~  
33 ~~preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force~~  
34 ~~and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.~~  
35 ~~If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become~~  
36 ~~effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor~~

1 ~~may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is~~  
2 ~~overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides~~  
3 ~~the veto.~~
