## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR COLLEGE BOARD  
10 APPROVED ADVANCED PLACEMENT TEACHER TRAINING FOR  
11 THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION FOR THE BIENNIAL  
12 PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 2005; AND FOR OTHER  
13 PURPOSES.

16 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION  
17 - COLLEGE BOARD APPROVED ADVANCED  
18 PLACEMENT TEACHER TRAINING APPROPRIATION  
19 FOR THE 2003-2005 BIENNIUM.

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
24

25 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - COLLEGE BOARD APPROVED ADVANCED PLACEMENT  
26 TEACHER TRAINING. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of  
27 Education, to be payable from the Department of Education Public School Fund  
28 Account, for College Board Approved Advanced Placement Teacher Training for  
29 the biennial period ending June 30, 2005, the following:

36 SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized



1 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds  
 2 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the  
 3 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and  
 4 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
 5 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
 6 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
 7 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
 8 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

9  
 10 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
 11 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
 12 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
 13 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
 14 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
 15 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
 16 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
 17 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

18  
 19 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
 20 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
 21 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the  
 22 effectiveness of this Act on the date of its passage and approval is  
 23 essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this  
 24 Act are provided due to the November 2002 Arkansas Supreme Court decision  
 25 regarding the Arkansas k-12 public school system, and that in the event of an  
 26 extension of the Second Extraordinary Session, the delay in the effective  
 27 date of this Act beyond the date of its passage and approval could work  
 28 irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential  
 29 governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist  
 30 and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public  
 31 peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the  
 32 date of its passage and approval.

33 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become  
 34 effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor  
 35 may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is  
 36 overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides

1 the veto.
