21	(a) There is created on the books of the Treasurer of State, the Auditor of State, and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a fund to be				
22	known as the Educational Adequacy Trust Fund.				
23	(b) The fund shall consist of all net revenues collected due to

12	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 84 th			
13	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas, meeting in Second Extraordinary			
14	Session, that this act is necessary due to the November 2002 Arkansas Supreme			
15	Court decision declaring the Arkansas public school system financially			
16	inadequate. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being			
17	immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and			
18	safety shall become effective on:			
19	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;			
20	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,			
21	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the			
22	bill; or			
23	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is			
24	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
