34 <u>SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General</u> 35 <u>Assembly, that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2004 is essential to</u> 36 <u>the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are</u>

7	preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force
