24	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

26	SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the			
27	Department of Education for the 2003-2005 biennium, which shall be			
28	supplemental and in addition to those positions authorized by Section 1 of			
29	Act 1608 of 2003, the following maximum number of regular employees whose			
30	salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification			
31	and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor,			
32	and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to

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SECTION 7. Section 9 of Act 51 of the First Extraordinary Session of 2003 is amended to read as follows:

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11 SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. PULASKI COUNTY DESEGREGATION. (A) For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2004 and for each fiscal year thereafter, the 12 13 Department of Education shall from time to time as needed, certify to the State Treasurer and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the amount of 14 15 funds disbursed or approved to be disbursed by the Department of Education 16 for desegregation expenses under the "Pulaski County School Desegregation 17 Settlement Agreement." Upon the receipt of such certification, the State Treasurer, after making those deductions as set out in Arkansas Code 19-5-18 19 202(b)(2)(B), shall also deduct up to, but not to exceed in total for fiscal year 2001-2002 2003-04 the sum of \$32,800,000 from the net general revenues 20 21 the amount certified and transfer this amount to the Department of Education 22 Public School Fund Account there to be used exclusively for payment of or 23 reimbursement for expenses incurred from the Department of Education Public 24 School Fund Account under the "Pulaski County School Desegregation Settlement 25 Agreement." 26 (B) For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2003 June 30, 2005, the Department of 27 Education shall from time to time as needed, certify to the State Treasurer 28 and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the amount of funds disbursed for 29 desegregation expenses under the "Pulaski County School Desegregation 30 Settlement Agreement." Upon the receipt of such certification, the State 31 Treasurer, after making those deductions as set out in Arkansas Code 19-5-32 202(b)(2)(B), shall also deduct up to, but not to exceed in total for fiscal 33 year 2002-2003 2004-05 the sum of \$32,800,000 from the net general revenues 34 and transfer this amount to the Department of Education Public School Fund 35 Account.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001

1 July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2003 June 30, 2005. 2 SECTION 8. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 3 4 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 5 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 6 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 7 8 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 9 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 10 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 11 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 12 13 SECTION 9. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 14 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 15 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 16 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 17 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 18 19 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 20 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 21 22 SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 23 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 24 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on the date of its passage and approval is 25 26 essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this 27 Act are provided due to the November 2002 Arkansas Supreme Court decision 28 regarding the Arkansas system of public schools, and that in the event of an 29 extension of the Second Extraordinary Session, the delay in the effective 30 date of this Act beyond the date of its passage and approval could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential 31 governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist 32 33 and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the 34
