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1	(b) Administrative consolidation assistance funds provided under		
2	subsection (a) of this section shall be paid in an amount equal to:		
3	(1) Eight hundred dollars (\$800) multiplied times the		
4	consolidated average daily membership; plus		
5	(2) Seven hundred dollars (\$700) multiplied times the		
6	consolidated national school lunch student total.		
7	(c) The state shall pay administrative consolidation assistance funds		
8	to each school district that:		
9	(1) Has an average daily membership of more than five hundred		
10	(500) for each of the two (2) school years preceding the school year in which		
11	the administrative consolidation or annexation petition is filed; and		
12	(2) Administratively consolidate or annex with another school		
13	district by to July 1, 2004.		
14	(d) Administrative consolidation assistance funds under subsection (c)		
15	of this section shall be paid in an amount equal to:		
16	(1) Eight hundred dollars (\$800) multiplied times five hundred		
17	<u>(500); and</u>		
18	(2) Seven hundred dollars (\$700) multiplied times the resulting		
19	district's national school lunch student total but not to exceed five hundred		
20	(500) national school lunch students.		
21	(e) No school district shall receive funding under both subsection (a)		
22	of this section and subsection (c) of this section, but shall receive the		
23	administrative consolidation assistance funds under the subsection that		
24	provides the most funding to the district.		
25	(c)(l)(l) Administrative consolidation assistance funds may be used		
26	by the school districts for any purpose.		
27	(2) However, the state board by rule may require funds to be		
28	expended on the construction or improvement of school facilities.		
29	(d)(f) The funds shall be paid to the resulting administratively		
30	consolidated or annexed school district during the first year of the		
31	consolidated or annexed district's existence.		
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
