16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

18	SECTION 1. School enrollment census Determining student drop-out			
19	rates.			
20	(a)(1)(A) On or before October 1 of each school year, a public school			
21	shall conduct a census of all students enrolled at the school to arrive at a			
22	school enrollment census total for each grade.			
23	(B) The number of students transferring into the school			
24	after October 1 but before the end of the school year shall be added to the			
25	October 1 school enrollment census total for each grade.			
26	<u>(C)</u>	The number of students transferring	g out of the school	
27	after October 1 but before the end of the school year shall be subtracted			
28	from the October 1 school enrollment census total for each grade.			
29	(2) The number of students transferring into or out of a school			
30	shall be based on the number of official transcripts received from other			
31	schools and the number of transcripts requested by other schools.			
32	(3) Each school shall maintain separate records regarding			
33	students who, after October 1 of each school year, leave the public school			
34	system to be home-schooled under Arkansas Code § 6-15-503.			
35	(b) The school enrollment census total as calculated and adjusted			
36	under subsection (a) of	f this section shall be used to dete	ermine the drop-out	



1	rate for each school as follows:		
2	(1) For grades kindergarten through eleven (K-11), the school		
3	enrollment census total for the current school year is compared to the school		
4	enrollment census total for each of the previous grades of the previous		
5	school year; and		
6	(2) For grade twelve (12), the current school year school		
7	enrollment census total for grade twelve (12) is compared to the school		
8	enrollment census total for grade eleven (11) of the previous year.		
9	(c) The graduation rates, as defined by the Department of Education,		
10	shall be tracked for students in grades nine through twelve (9-12).		
11	(d) The Department of Education shall use this section for in-state		
12	reporting purposes related to school drop-out rates.		
13	(e) The State Board of Education shall promulgate rules to require		
14	school districts to report graduation and drop-out rates each year in		
15	accordance with this section.
