3	Utilization Review and served as a member and physician advisor to the	
4	Arkansas Foundation for Medical Care; and

7	Medical Center, serving twice as a member of the hospital's Board of	
8	Governors and being honored by the hospital in 1981 when its conference	
9	center was named after him; and

13	medical director of the hospital; and
