3	from 1966 until 1981; served on the Arkansas Hospital Association Board,

6	the Crime Victims Reparations Board from 1989 until 1992; and

9	capacities in the White County Democrat organization; served on the Kensett
10	Cemetery Board; and was named Outstanding Citizen of the State of Arkansas in
11	1991 by Governor Bill Clinton; and
