22 WHEREAS, The Consortium for Mathematics and its Applications (COMAP) is
23 an award-winning non-profit organization whose mission is to improve
24 mathematics education for students of all ages; and

26 WHEREAS, Since 1980, The Consortium for Mathematics and its
27 Applications (COMAP) has worked with teachers, students, and business people
28 to create learning environments where mathematics is used to investigate and
29 model real issues in our world; and

31 WHEREAS, in November 2003, The Consortium for Mathematics and its
32 Applications (COMAP) held the Sixth Annual High School Mathematical COMAP
33 Modeling (HiMCM) contest, with a total of two hundred seventy-four (274)
34 teams, with up to four (4) students each, from fifty-nine (59) different
35 schools competing; and

2 Sciences and the Arts competed in the contest - Audrey Morris of
3 Russellville, Katherine Herring of Conway, Johnson Wong of Little Rock, and
4 Alex Wong of Searcy, with the team being led by Bruce Turkal; and

6 WHEREAS, the Arkansas School for Mathematics Sciences and the Arts
7 earned a "National Outstanding" designation and a "Regional Outstanding"
8 designation; and
