25	WHEREAS, our Creator, who endowed all people with certain unalienable
26	rights, also established the union of one man and one woman as the first and
27	most essential institution in society; and

29	WHEREAS, throughout human history the family of one man, one woman, and
30	their children has been the core social unit of healthy and flourishing
31	cultures; and

33	WHEREAS, in 1997, the Arkansas General Assembly passed a Defense of
34	Marriage Act prohibiting marriages between persons of the same sex and
35	denying marital benefits to same sex marriages; and

1	WHEREAS, it is the public policy of the State of Arkansas to recognize
2	the marital union only of one man and one woman;
3	
4	WHEREAS, recently there have been serious attempts to change the
5	historical definition of marriage through legislation and judicial action;
6	and

8	WHEREAS, recent court action outside of Arkansas may jeopardize the
9	enforcement of Arkansas' Defense of Marriage Act,
10	
11	NOW THEREFORE,
12	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-FOURTH GENERAL
13	ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
14	
15	THAT the House of Representatives of the Eighty-fourth General Assembly
16	of the State of Arkansas requests that all members of Arkansas' delegation to
17	the United States House of Representatives and the United States Senate
18	support the Federal Marriage Amendment to the United States Constitution.
