23	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

25	SECTION 1. Section 2 of Act 1284 of 2003, Regular Session, regarding			
26	the allocation of funds each fiscal year is repealed as follows:

36	SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS.	Disbursement of funds		

- l authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
- 2 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
- 3 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
- 4 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
- 5 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
- 6 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
- 7 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
- 8 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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- 10 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
- 11 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
- 12 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
- 13 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
- 14 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
- 15 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
- 16 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
- 17 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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- 19 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
- 20 Assembly, that the effectiveness of this Act on the date of its passage and
- 21 approval is essential due to the November 2002 Arkansas Supreme Court ruling
- 22 that the State has not fulfilled its constitutional duty to provide the
- 23 children of this state with a general, suitable, and efficient educational
- 24 system; and that in order to initiate immediate progress towards implementing
- 25 a constitutional public k-12 school facilities program the effectiveness of
- 26 this Act on the date of its passage and approval is essential to the
- 27 operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided
- 28 and that in the event of an extension of the Second Extraordinary Session of
- 29 2003, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond the date of its
- 30 passage and approval could work irreparable harm upon the proper
- 31 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore,
- 32 an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being immediately
- 33 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall
- 34 become effective on:
- 35 (A) The date of its approval by the Governor;
- 36 (B) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, the
