26	SECTION 1. APPROPRIATI	ON - GEOGRAPHIC INFORMATION SYST	'EM OFFICE. There is

36	SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE	WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement o	f funds authorized	



1 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 2 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 3 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and 4 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 5 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 6 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 7 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 8 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

10 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 11 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 12 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 13 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 14 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 15 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 16 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 17 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 19 20 Assembly, that the effectiveness of this Act is essential for the 21 implementation of enterprise-level GIS projects that will eliminate redundant 22 systems, improve electronic government service for Arkansas citizens and 23 enhance economic development opportunities in Arkansas. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the 24 immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in 25 26 full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval. 27 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become 28 effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor 29 may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is 30 overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides 31 the veto. 32 33 34 35
