10 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL
11 SERVICES AND OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE
12 UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS - ARKANSAS SCHOOL FOR
13 MATHEMATICS, SCIENCES, AND THE ARTS FOR THE
14 BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 2005; AND FOR
15 OTHER PURPOSES.

19 AN ACT FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS -
20 ARKANSAS SCHOOL FOR MATHEMATICS,
21 SCIENCES, AND THE ARTS APPROPRIATION FOR

25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
26

27 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - ARKANSAS SCHOOL FOR MATHEMATICS, SCIENCES, AND
28 THE ARTS. There is hereby appropriated, to the University of Arkansas, to be
29 payable from the School for Math, Science and Arts Fund, for personal
30 services and operating expenses of the University of Arkansas-Arkansas School
31 for Mathematics, Sciences, and the Arts for the biennial period ending June
32 30, 2005, the following:

3 SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
4 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
5 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
6 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
7 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
8 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures
9 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this
10 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of
11 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied
12 with in disbursement of said funds.
13

14 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
15 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
16 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
17 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
18 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
19 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
20 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
21 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
22

23 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
24 Assembly, that appropriation for the Arkansas School for Mathematics,
25 Sciences, and the Arts is necessary to continue its normal operations and
26 activities following the merger with the University of Arkansas at
27 Fayetteville which becomes effective on January 1, 2004. Therefore, an
28 emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the
29 immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in
30 full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.

31 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become
32 effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor
33 may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
34 overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides
35 the veto.
